## SPRING BANS ARE ON THE WAY ...

## ALL ROAD USERS MUST HAVE A PERMIT TO USE THE ROAD.

## PERMITS ARE OBTAINED FROM ANCROAD.COM

ANC would like to remind users of the spring road ban guidelines:

## **Guidelines/Restrictions:**

- ANC Spring Road Bans typically start beginning to mid-March and remain in effect until the beginning of June (2 to 3 months).
- > Typically starts with daytime 12-hour ban and then switches to 24-hours
  - Trucks hauling produced fluids will be charged \$300.00 per load during the 12hour ban
- > Timeline is strictly dependent on the weather and road conditions.
- > Please plan ahead to minimize the traffic during the spring ban period.
  - Travel is NOT restricted for vehicles under 1 ton (1 ton or under = 350/3500 series and under)
  - All traffic over 1 ton is required to STOP at the 103 km security gate and provide their approved permit number obtained from <u>WWW.ancroad.com</u>
  - One permit per surface legal location is required. You can use the same permit number for this location for the entire ban period
  - All traffic over 1 ton (heavy loads) are subject to road use fees as per the rate schedule:

• Valid road use agreement must be in place for each legal location being accessed.
